The range and diversity of Indigenous rock art in the general area of Faraway Bay is extraordinary. Our location appears to have been a mecca for Ice Age painters, with some of the most unique examples of the mysterious Bradshaw rock art in Australia.

You will be taken on a journey of discovery and amazement to sites often located within unusual geological rock formations. These breathtaking locations are some of the most secluded and unique in the region, and are usually not accessed by the general public.

Access to the rock art sites at Faraway Bay is mostly by boat, however minimal vehicle access and walking tours can also take the keen rock art enthusiast into some magnificent sites.

Back at Eagle Lodge, be captivated by the storytelling of Ju Ju as she paints. A talented artist herself, Ju Ju is fascinating to watch, listen to and learn from.


Take a walking tour to learn about traditional bush tucker and bush medicine. Ju Ju will show you how food was gathered by Indigenous people many years ago and introduce you to the plants used to create traditional medicines.
